2018 RADIATION SAFETY OFFICER (RSO) TRAINING COURSE

This course is designed to equip individuals appointed as facility Radiation Safety Officers (RSOs) with the necessary skills and competencies required to effectively carry out their duties as stipulated by the law.

Section 16 of the Radiation Protection Act [Chapter 15:15] states; *"The owner or occupier of a facility shall appoint a person experienced in radiation health and safety measures as a radiation safety officer within the facility..."*

Course Objectives

- To build a universal understanding of the radiation hazard and its characteristics.
- To raise the level of expertise on facility radiation risk management.
- To enhance knowledge of regulatory requirements among Radiation Safety Officers.
